

## The project Women War and Peace was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"

**Participation:** The project in Germany involved 140 citizens (45 female, 95 male) in six public activities, notably 126 participants from the city of Hannover (Germany) and 14 participants from the city of Berlin (Germany). A further 6,000 were reached through dissemination activities.

**Location/ Dates:** Events took place from 5/08/2016 to 17/11/2016. Event 1 involved 36 citizens and took place in The University of Leibniz, Welfengarten 1, 30167, Hannover, Germany, from 10/11/2016 to 10/11/2016. Event 2 involved 9 citizens and took place in Mensa 105, Schneiderberg, Hannover Germany, from 17/11/2016 to 17/11/2016. Event 3 involved 35 citizens and took place in Leibniz Universität, Schneiderberg 50, 30167 Hannover, Germany, from 05/08/2016 to 06/08/2016. Event 4 involved 32 citizens and took place in Universität Hannover, Schneiderberg 50, Raum V405/V407/V410/V411, Germany, 24/09/2016 and 05/11/2016. Event 5 involved 14 citizens and took place in Kolloquium Politische Bildung, Callinstr. 20, Hannover, Germany, from 18/11/2016 to 18/11/2016. Event 6 involved 14 citizens and took place in 12049 Berlin, Weise Str 50., Germany, from 12/11/2016 to 12/11/2016.
