

The project Women War and Peace was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens".

Applicable to Strand 1 European Remembrance

Participation: The project in Poland involved 423 citizens (151 female, 272 male) in nine public activities notably 406 citizens from the city of Lodz in Poland and 17 citizens from Kobe, Japan. The project involved 143 citizens who attended eight project workshops in Poland – Events 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 11 – and an additional 280 participants who attended the XBI International Scientific Conference – Event One – making a grand total of 423 citizens. In terms of Media Activities the project involved 20,000 radio listeners - Event Ten – and involved 112,000 TVTOYA spectators – Event Eleven - making a total reach via publicity and dissemination of 132,000. A transnational partner project meeting was held in Poland on 19 and 20 May 2016 attended by 7 participants from the four partner organisations.

Location/ Dates: The events took place in the University of Humanities and Economics, Lodz, Poland; in Radio Lodz, in Lodz, Poland; in TVTOYA, Lodz, Poland; and UAM Poznan, Slubice, Kościuszki 1, 69-100 Slubice, Poland from 04/02/2016 to 03/11/2016.

Short description:

Women, War and Peace is an innovative yearlong transnational project with four European partners from Ireland, Spain, Germany and Poland. The project uses creative processes of theatre and film to explore the role of women in Europe from WWII and the power of the EU in promoting peace and gender equality today. The project is co-funded by the **Europe for Citizens programme of the European Union** and the four European partners are: Smashing Times Theatre Company, Ireland, www.smashingtimes.ie; Institute de Formacion Y Estudios Sociales (IFES), Valencia, Spain, www.ifes.es; Gottfried Wilhelm Leibniz Universitaet, Hannover, Germany, www.uni-hannover.de; and the University of Humanities and Economics in Lodz, Poland, www.ahe.lodz.pl.

The project activities in Poland reached a total of 423 citizens through workshops and a total of 132,000 citizens through media events.

The day of 04-05/02/2016, Event One, was dedicated to a conference and project information and was attended by 280 citizens

The day of 08/04/2016, Event Two, was dedicated to project workshops and was attended by 4 citizens.

The day of 09/04/2016, Event Three, was dedicated to project workshops and was attended by 9 citizens.

The day of 24/04/2016, Event Four, was dedicated to project workshops and was attended by 17 citizens.

The day of 11/05/2016, Event Five, and 15/05/2016 was dedicated to project workshops and was attended by 28 citizens.

The day of 06/06/2016, Event Six, was dedicated to project workshops and was attended by 3 citizens.

The day of 09/06/2016, Event Seven, was dedicated to project workshops and was attended by 43 citizens.

The day of 03/08/2016, Event Eight, was dedicated to project workshops and was attended by 17 citizens.

The day of 03/11/2016, Event Nine, was dedicated to project workshops and was attended by 22 citizens.

The day of 22/08/2016, Event Ten, was dedicated to radio broadcast and reached 20,000 citizens.

The day of 23/08/2016, Event Eleven, was dedicated to TV programme and reached 112,000 citizens.
